President David Barnwell called the Fourth General Meeting of the Society for Irish Latin American Studies to order at 5:00pm. A quorum was established as existing and it was noted that there were three proxy votes.

4. Members Fees

The Secretary reported a Society's loss of 550 Euros from unpaid fees, i.e., 26.8 per cent of the closing year's fees receivable. Members discussed different ways to facilitate the collection of funds, including credit cards and e-payment.

6. Grants

The third academic year of the Irish Latin American Research Fund was launched in February and seventeen applications were received so far. Members analysed the results of the programme and thanked the effort of the Selection Committee members (professors Laura Izarra, Kerby Miller and Angus Mitchell), as well as the generous support of members and friends: Herman and Maria Ana Beuk, Harry Dunleavy, Jim Geoghegan, Cathal McGoey, Bill Mulligan, Peter Mulvany, Edmundo Murray, Hugh Fitzgerald Ryan.

7. Conferences

Three panels on the Irish in Latin America have been implemented to date (Liverpool 2004, Maynooth 2005 and Coleraine 2006). The first SILAS conference is being organised by the Conference Committee (Claire Healy and Oliver Marshall). It will be held on 26-29 June 2007 at the Irish Studies Centre of the National University of Ireland in Galway, together with the Fifth International Conference on Colonialism. Claire Healy reported on the planning and presented the call for papers to be launched before the end of June 2006.

8. Funding

David Barnwell reported on the Funding Committee and also presented a draft brochure to be distributed among visitors to Westmeath and Mullingar schools.

9. Elections of Executive Committee Members and Auditor

Secretary's Report

1. MEMBERSHIP

In the last twelve months (May 2005 to April 2006) the Society has greatly improved in all its activities. I am happy to report a 28% increase in membership, with 23 new Members who joined in this period. So far, the Society has 82 Members (24 May 2006), including seventy-one Senior Members, eight Student Members and three Honorary Members.

Chart 1. SILAS Membership 2003-2006 (to 30 April 2006)

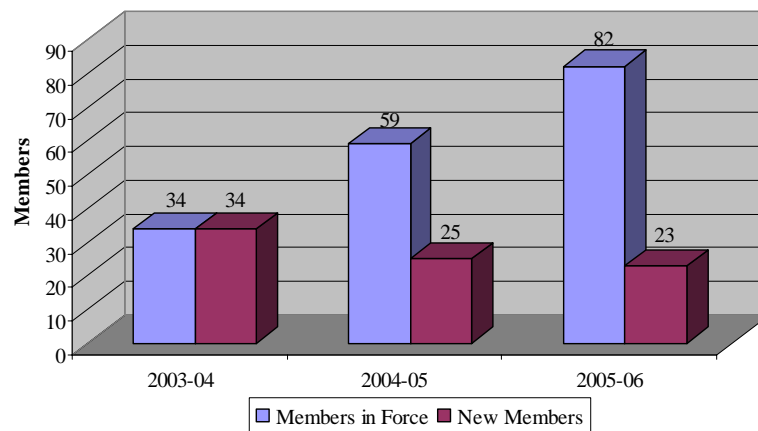
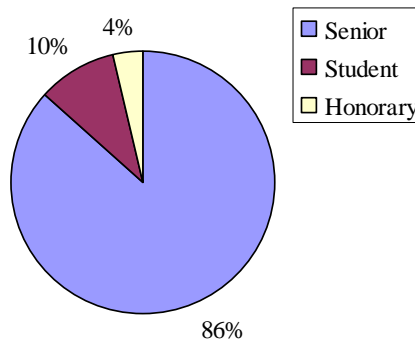


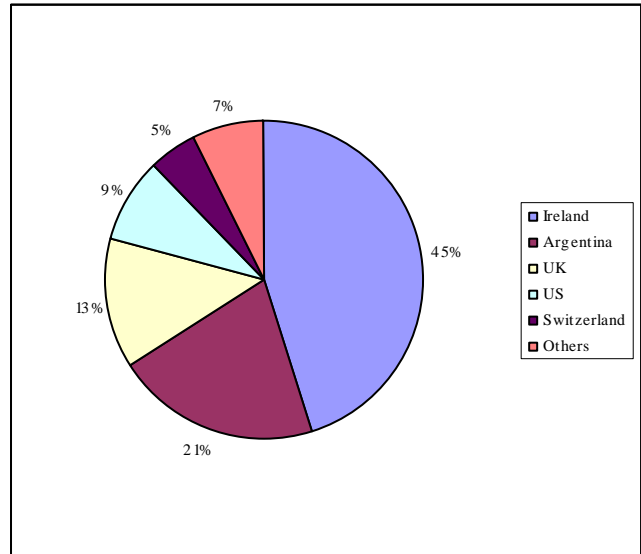
Chart 2. SILAS Membership by Type of Members



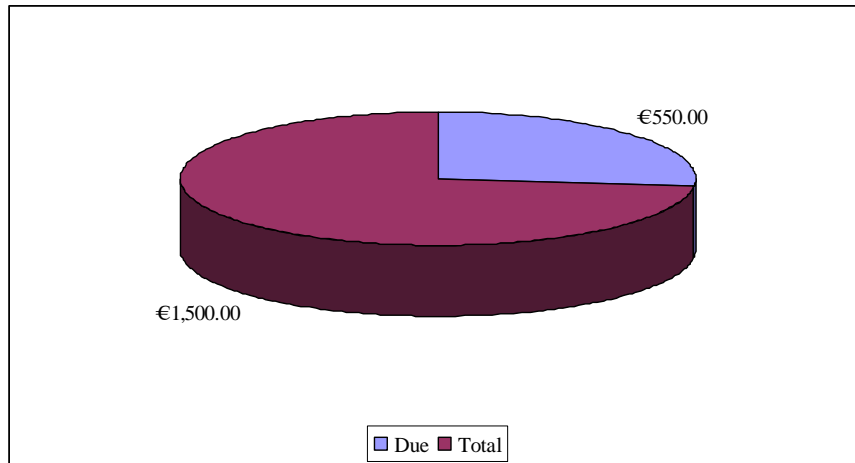
The quantity of Members is encouraging, though there is an important concentration of Members based in Ireland and Argentina.

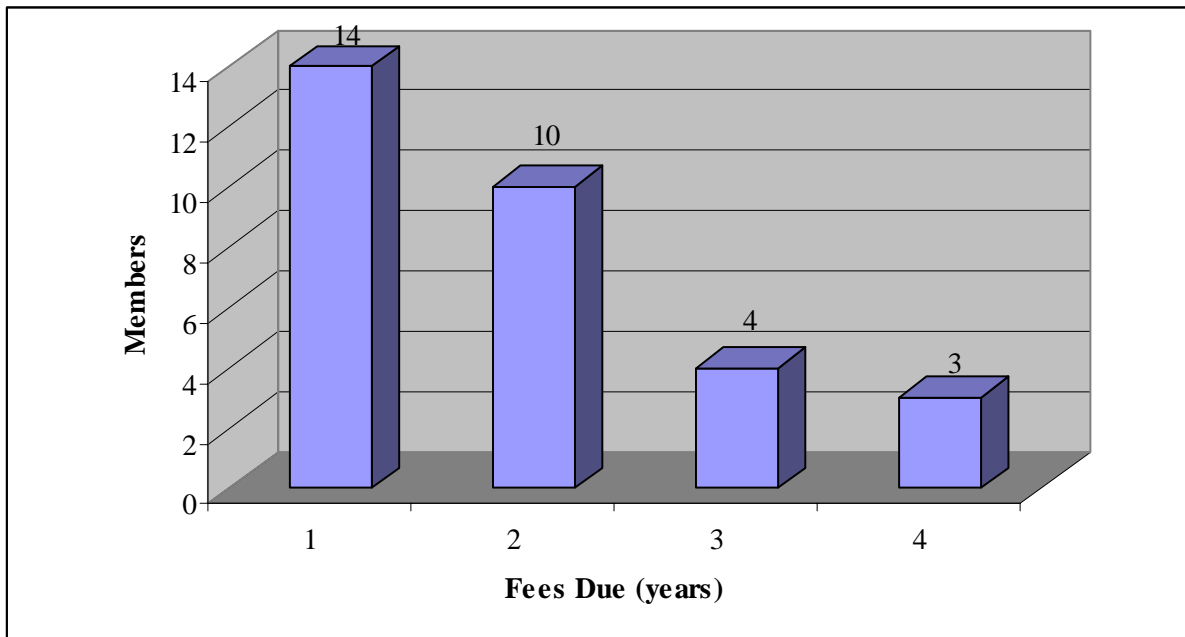

However, not all Members pay their fees. For an organisation that relies heavily on Members' fees and donations, a 25% unpaid fees is significant.

These unpaid fees are owed by 31 Members, i.e., 40 per cent of Membership (except the Honorary Members). It is interesting to note that most Members with fees due owe one or two years.

We hope that all Members will understand the importance of their fees and donations as the only resource available to fund all our activities.

2. TREASURY

Two Treasury-related issues are important to highlight in this report. On the one hand, SILAS is an international non-profit organisation headquartered in Switzerland. Consequently, the Society's funds are placed in a Swiss bank, currently UBS of Geneva. The account holder is still under the previous name, i.e., Irish Argentine Historical Society, and this situation should be changed in order to avoid misunderstandings. On the other hand, even if the amounts received by the Society are relatively low, the expenses derived from international cheque cashing deserve the opening of other payment vehicles for fees and donations, particularly credit cards and e-payments.

3. PUBLICATIONS

Regarding SILAS publications, we edit a website (www.irlandeses.org) since 2003. Since January 2005, the website includes a serial publication, *Irish Migration Studies in Latin America*, which we intend to publish every quarter (previously every two months). This publication is registered under ISSN 1661-6065 and is given volume and issue numbers. Also, as in the case of an increasing number of academic journals, a paginated version is published in the website so readers who need to cite articles are provided the complete reference.

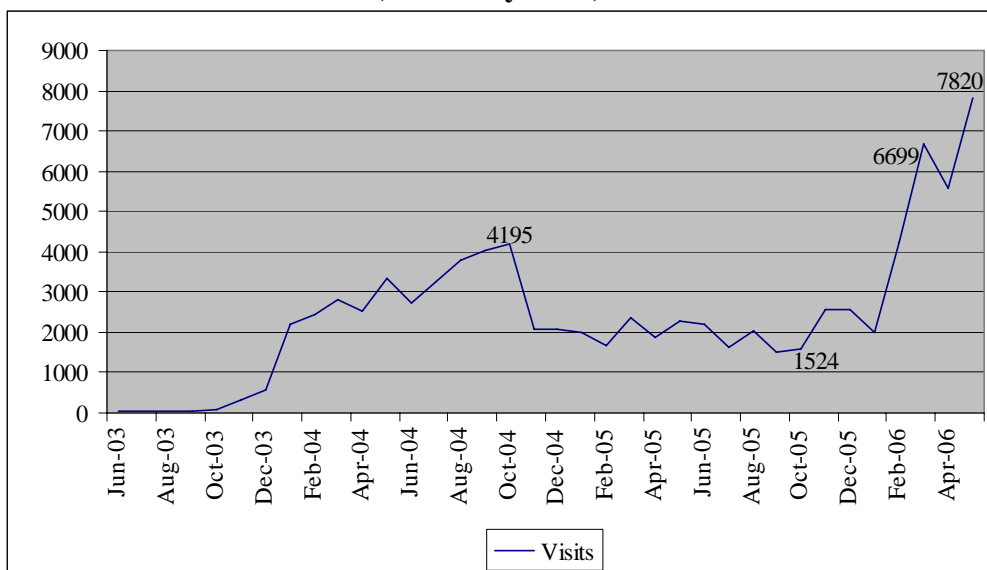

The website and the associated publication are extremely effective. For a very low cost, which includes the domain names and the hosting service, a growing number of visitors have access to our information.

Chart 5. Website Visits 2003-2006 (to 31 May 2006)



Monthly visits increased from a few dozens in the first publications of 2003 to 7,820 in May 2006. In November 2004 a new page design was implemented, which caused a loss of visits from certain Internet browsers (eg., Netscape). A technical solution was developed for this problem later in 2005. Record daily visits were recorded on 8 May 2006 (385), followed by 16 March 2006 (333), being related to the Irish in Colombia special edition (Vol. 4, N° 2 - March 2006) and St. Patrick's Day respectively. In May 2006 the pdf version of the publication was downloaded 492 times (Vol. 4, N°2) and 159 times (Vol. 4, N° 1). The next issue (July 2006) will include other sections, such as Book Reviews, Sources and Feedback. As from 6 May 2006, the hosting service provider was changed from Lycos Europe to Infomaniak of Switzerland.

Two persons have been fundamental to the success of this publication. I am greatly indebted to Claire Healy of Dublin, who plays a key role as Associate Editor, and Ignacio Adrogué, IT specialist of Geneva for their valuable assistance. I am also thankful to the growing number of contributors and to Members and friends who submit primary sources for publication and who provide constant feedback.

4. GRANTS PROGRAMME

The Grants Programme of the Society for Irish Latin American Studies (SILAS) was introduced in March 2004 to support innovative and significant research in the different aspects of migrations between Ireland and Latin America. The grants programme name is **Irish Latin American Research Fund**.

Grants up to 1,000 Euros are awarded to exceptionally promising students, faculty members or independent scholars to help support their research and writing leading to the publication or other types of communication of their projects. Awards are selected on the basis of a well-developed research plan that promises to make a significant contribution to a particular area of study about the Irish and Latin America. Typically, grants funds are used to pay for travel expenses to distant archives.

Every year three prestigious scholars seat on the selection committee to assess the research proposals and award grants to the best projects. The Irish Latin American Research Fund is open to faculty, advanced university students, and independent scholars throughout the world. Funding for the grants programme is obtained from individuals and private sources, namely from SILAS members and friends.

5. MANUSCRIPTS AND RARE BOOKS COLLECTION

The Manuscripts and Rare Books Collection (MRBC) was created in May 2005 to allow Members and others to contribute to the preservation of Irish heritage and aid historical research on relations between Ireland and Latin America.

SILAS has signed a twenty-five years repository contract with the Max von Buch Library of Universidad de San Andrés (Buenos Aires). This library provides optimal security and technical conditions for documents and rare books belonging to SILAS, its Members and friends. The library staff is trained to preserve records using the latest available technology. Furthermore, the Max von Buch Library has been collecting a number of invaluable holdings of the British and Irish communities in Argentina, including among others the most complete collection of the *Standard* newspaper in existence in a public library (1861-1959), the Cecilia Grierson Papers (1859-1934), and the records of 'The Strangers Club' of Buenos Aires (1841-1981). To this, SILAS added the **Anastasia Joyce Papers (1844-1881)** donated by Mary Anglim, including the letters to Martin Murphy of Co. Wexford. The collection has been recently received in Buenos Aires and is being now classified and catalogued by the librarians.


